

GET YOUR NPDB SELF-QUERY

Health care professionals can find out if there is a report about them in the National Practitioner Data Bank by ordering a Self-Query.

Note: To perform a Self-Query, you must first verify your identity by using an ID.me account. See the How to Verify your Identity help page.

Verify your identity:
Use ID.me to complete identity verification for your user account.



Complete the Self-Query form with your identifying information.



Enter your payment information to proceed with your order.



Get your online results in minutes.

The results show any reports found, or if no reports were found.

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Paper Self-Queries are available upon request for an additional fee. Paper copies are delivered through USPS certified first class mail, requiring a signature upon delivery. **Do not open your envelope** if you are sending your paper results to an organization.



Your Self-Query response is only valid for 45 days from the process date. You will need to submit a new Self-Query order each time a response is needed.
